This four day course seeks to enhance the application of monitoring and evaluation practices and to promote greater harmonization of approaches methodologies, practices and tools within the UN System. Overall, this course will enable participants to understand the role monitoring and evaluation play in supporting and enhancing the UN's normative work at the country level.

Course Objectives

By the end of the workshop, participants will:

- Have a better understanding of the role of monitoring and evaluation in the UN system;
- Further develop their knowledge and skills in designing of monitoring and evaluation plans as well as evaluation design and methodology;
- Have an overview of the management of evaluation; and,
- Exchange experiences, lessons learned and good practices emanating from the UN system and international cooperation.
