Objectives

Upon successful completion of the programme you will be able to:

- Identify your own leadership style, while recognizing the strengths to build on and the challenges to face
- Develop public-speaking and facilitation techniques to apply in front of a wide array of audiences
- Cultivate stronger connections by networking with UN colleagues working in various duty stations
- Identify effective techniques to prepare for a negotiation and to influence relevant stakeholders

Course Contents

In this programme you will go through a self-awareness journey. You will discover the most effective leadership styles in your working environment and practical communication and influencing techniques to apply.

- Leadership concepts and styles of leadership
- Emotional resilience and confidence
- Exploring individual strengths and weaknesses through 360 assessment
- Influencing and managing upwards
- Peer coaching
- Public speaking and facilitation

Course Methodology

This face-to-face leadership programme combines lectures by external experts and senior UN staff with interactive and participatory sessions and exercises. You will analyse relevant case studies, exchange with peers your and their experiences, and practice different skills to apply in the workplace.

You will be asked to complete a 360 assessment to share with your colleagues before arriving to the training. The five-day training will require your full attention for at least 6.5 hours per day.

Target Audience

UN staff at the P3 level or P2 level with managerial experience and responsibilities.

Cost of participation

The programme fee of \$3,000 covers:

- A pre-residential component, including a 360° leadership assessment and/or personality assessment and pre-readings;
- A five-day face-to-face training;
- All learning material and access to the UNSSC learning platform;
- One networking event with faculty members and programme participants;
- Follow up activities and continued alumni networking opportunities.

Refreshments will be provided during the programme. The fee does not include travel, accommodation, meals and other incidentals.
