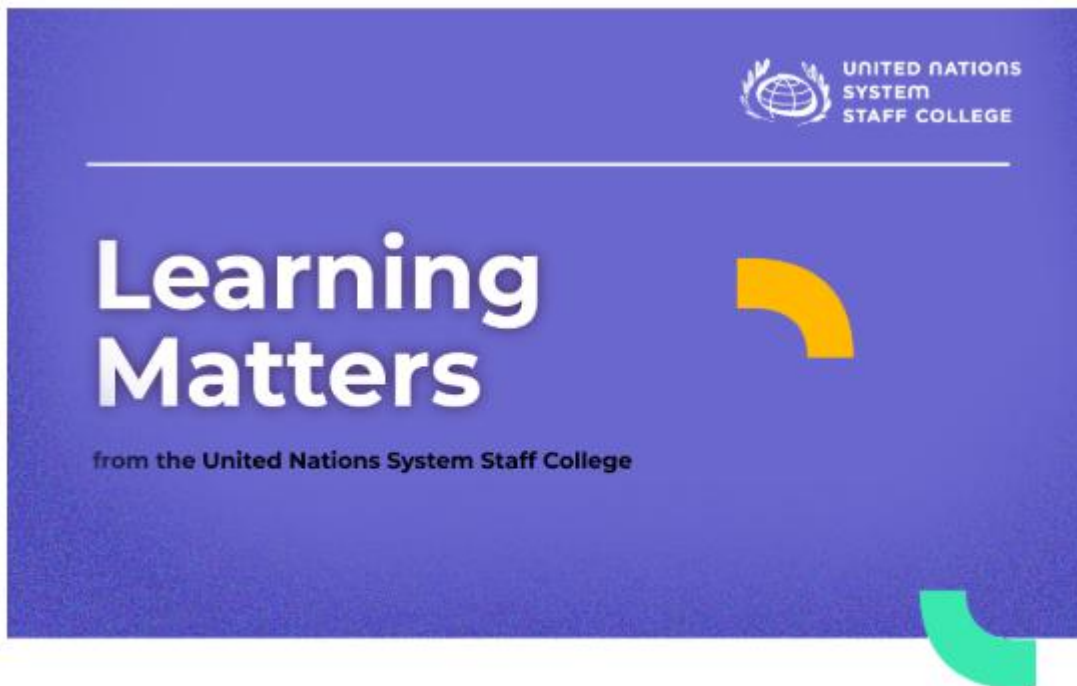

Embedding monitoring and evaluation systems in conflict-affected settings

This month, in Mogadishu, UNSSC brought together 21 staff from the United Nations Support Office in Somalia (UNSOS) for an intensive three-day training on monitoring and evaluation (M&E). In conflict-affected settings, M&E systems are critical to understand what's working, what's not, and how to adapt quickly. During the training, participants learnt to design logical frameworks and theories of change, develop performance indicators and data collection tools, and discovered data analysis techniques to interpret findings and produce clear, actionable reports to inform decision-making and adaptive management in real time.
