This course, designed by the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP)'s Bureau for Policy and Programme Support SDG Integration team and the United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF), with support from UNSSC, trains participants on a common approach and a core set of tools for delivering (SDG) policy integration support to governments. Participants in this course are welcome to join the Integrated Policy Practitioner's Network - (co-led by nine UN agencies) to maintain connections and participate in discussions of relevant tools and methods.

TARGET AUDIENCE: UN staff from headquarters, country teams or regional offices, government representatives, development practitioners as well as members of civil society, the private sector, academia and foundations.



Social Protection for Sustainable Development

This interactive and facilitated six-week course is designed for anyone interested in learning the basics of social protection and how to apply it through the lens of sustainable development. The course champions a universal, life-cycle approach focusing on partnerships, designing, financing, and implementing comprehensive social protection systems that reduce the vulnerabilities faced by all.

TARGET AUDIENCE: Civil society, academia, the private sector, mass media, political parties, governments, NGOs, international organizations, donors, social workers, educators, volunteers, and influencers. Thought Leadership Course - Synergizing Disaster Risk Reduction and Climate Change Adaptation

Disaster risk reduction (DRR) and climate change adaptation are synergistic, given the common risk-reduction and vulnerability-reduction objectives of both actions. However, the governance of the two has evolved in parallel at both global and national levels. National DRR strategies and national adaptation plans are often developed in isolation from each other, resulting in a suboptimal utilization of resources. In this thought leadership module, developed in partnership with the UN Office for Disaster Risk Reduction, you will explore the fundamental aspects of harnessing disaster risk reduction and climate change adaptation synergies and the lessons learnt by those who are at the forefront of comprehensive disaster and climate risk management.

TARGET AUDIENCE: The module is targeted at decision-makers and shapers, and disaster risk reduction and climate change adaptation focal points, who are directly involved in developing national disaster risk reduction strategies and national adaptation plans at the local, subnational, national, regional, and international levels.

Other officials and stakeholders that can contribute to advancing disaster risk reduction and climate change adaptation synergies can also make use of the course.



Circular Economy and the 2030 Agenda

Systems-based approaches along with a strong commitment to deep-rooted transformations and actions are vital to the reduction of humanity's footprint on our planet. Our resources are finite, and the principles and practices of the circular economy will be catalytic in creating goods, processes and ecosystems that are restorative and regenerative by design. This course will focus on 'how' and 'why' circular economy principles will be critical to achieving the 2030 Agenda.

Theoretical, practical and case study-based approaches will be used to illustrate and support the concepts. Your learning will be strongly application-based, with numerous real-life examples from around the world, and will include useful tools to advance practices.

TARGET AUDIENCE: Policymakers and policy shapers from the multilateral sector and government, members of the private sector and civil society who would like to help accelerate the transition towards circular systems by applying circular economy principles in policymaking, production and consumption practices, businesses and cities.

Climate Transparency and the Enhanced Transparency Framework (ETF)

The Initiative for Climate Action Transparency (ICAT), United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC), the CBIT-GSP developed by the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) and implemented by the UNEP Climate Centre in Copenhagen, and the United Nations System Staff College (UNSSC), have collaborated to develop this course that aims to support developing countries to boost national capacity to implement the Enhanced Transparency Framework (ETF) under the Paris Agreement. In particular, this course will help countries enhance their ability to implement the ETF in a way that advances international and domestic climate policy objectives and enables the realization of national priorities and Sustainable Development Goals.

TARGET AUDIENCE: The course seeks participants engaged in policy development, advisory, research and programming roles. These can include:

- Senior government officials working in ministries/national bodies relevant to national climate change actions, with some responsibility in supporting policy development;
- Technical practitioners working in the domain of climate reporting and data collection.

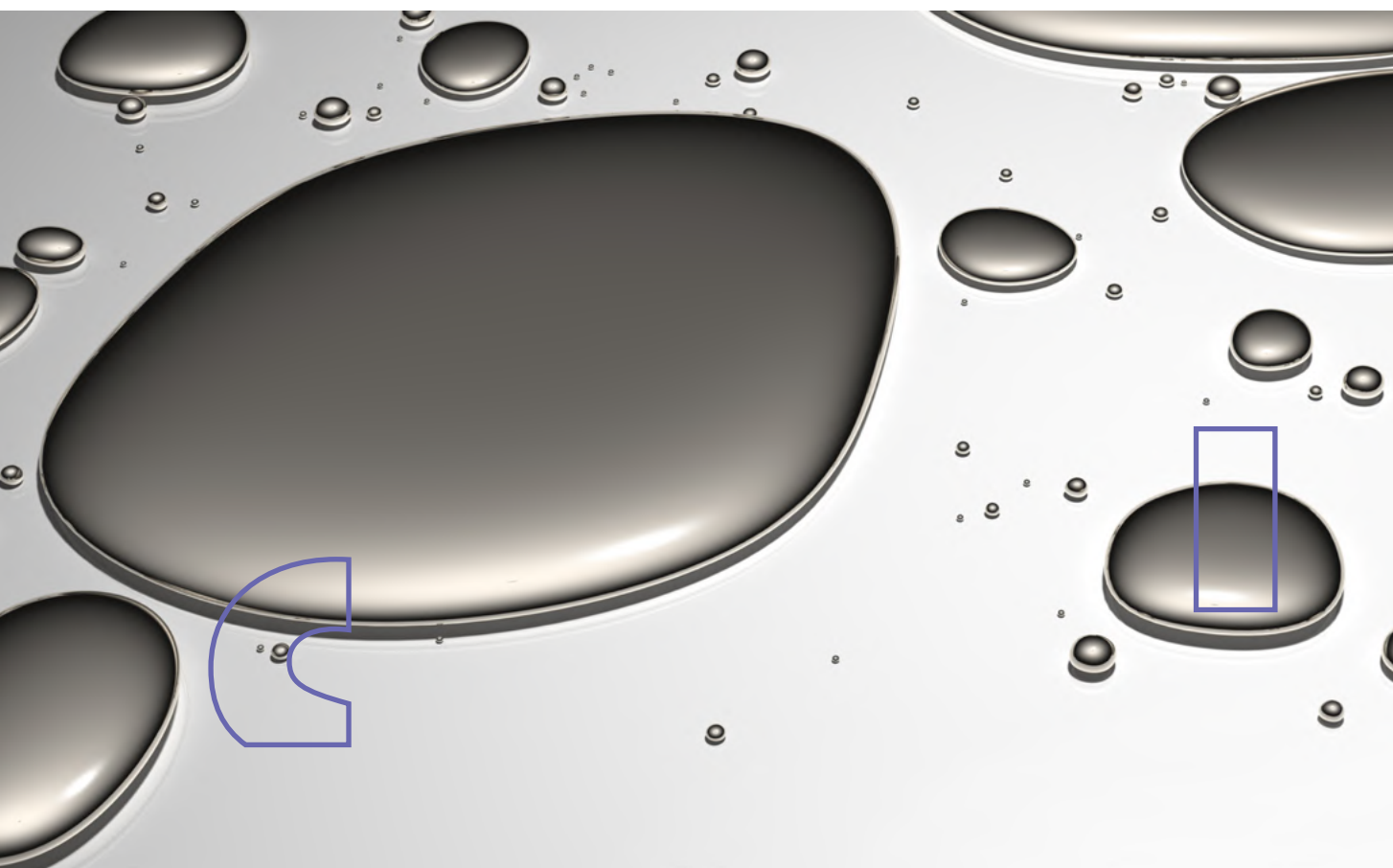

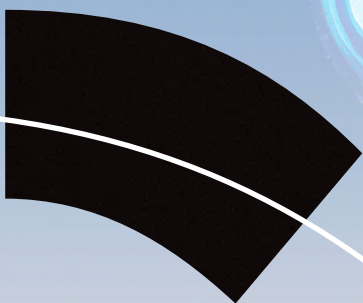

This course, developed in partnership with the Development Coordination Office, focuses on joint business operations with the purpose of eliminating duplication, leveraging the common bargaining power of the UN, and maximizing economies of scale. It is part of the ambitious capacity development effort towards the establishment of a single team to support services for the entire UN Country Team in areas relating to administration, finance, human resources, information and technology, logistics, and procurement. By completing this self-paced training programme, participants will also gain practical skills in all steps of BOS 2.0 dealing with resistance and in completing a change impact analysis.

TARGET AUDIENCE: Operations staff based in country and regional offices. Programme staff are welcome if they have basic operational knowledge in one or more lines of operation (procurement, finance, human resources, ICT, logistics or administration) and an interest in supporting the BOS strategy in the country. The course is open to non-UN participants, consultants and/or Member States.
