



Scholarship Announcement: Virtual UN Summer Academy 2020

As the world community marks 75 years of the UN, the virtual UN Summer Academy will focus on the theme “The Future We Want”. In this immersive online learning experience, participants will examine the challenges and opportunities facing today’s multilateral development system and explore key actions at global and local levels to drive a sustainable future.

In order to offer highly -qualified candidates the possibility to participate in the online UN Summer Academy, the state of North Rhine-Westphalia (NRW), Germany, is funding 50 full scholarships, covering fees for the five-day online learning event.

Scholarship eligibility criteria

To qualify for a scholarship, you must meet the following criteria:

- have professional or academic experience in the area of sustainable development;
- be able to act as multiplier, applying and passing on acquired knowledge; and
- be available to actively participate. The virtual Summer Academy is synchronous, meaning participants are expected to be online at the same time during specified hours (either 10:00am-4:00pm CEST or 2:00pm-8:00pm CEST) every day, 24-28 August 2020.

Applicants from NRW and its partner countries and regions (Benelux countries, Ghana, China, and the U.S.A) are strongly encouraged to apply.
