The theme of the 2018 edition of the UN Summer Academy '**Bringing the 2030 Agenda to Life**' will focus on engaging different stakeholders, creating coherent policies across areas and levels of governance, building effective partnerships and strengthening review and monitoring mechanisms to achieve the goals of the 2030 Agenda.
